**Questions from the Board on matters not on
the agenda**

Given the importance of the identification of 'individual vulnerability' in reducing the risk of harm in those crime types which are rising (child sexual abuse and domestic violence):

1. How many individuals are currently identified as 'vulnerable'?
2. What is the distribution across the Local Policing Units (LPUs)?
3. What is the relative increase/decrease over the past 12 months?
4. How many individuals have been identified by local authorities via Multi Agency Safeguarding Hubs (MASHs)?
