Thank you for your freedom of information request received in this office on **25 June** 2024, in which you asked:

- 1. 'When are you next going through an audit of the national fraud initiative?
- 2. What current procedures do you have in place such as confirmation of payee against fraud?
- 3. What is your current confirmation of payee software incumbent product & the renewal date of the contract.'

On 05 July, you clarified your request, and we have based our response on the following:

'What date is it you're next going through the data matching exercise of the national fraud initative?'

In response to your request, I can confirm that the NFI exercise is undertaken every two years. The OPCC are due to submit data to the Cabinet Office in October 2024 and the data matches will be released by Cabinet Office around January-February 2025.

Freedom of Information Right of Appeal
